Fiserv Forum to host Marquette/Wisconsin match Sept. 17

Fiserv Forum will host an NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball match between in-state rivals Marquette University and the University of Wisconsin on Wednesday, Sept. 17, 2025, in downtown Milwaukee.

Tickets for the match at the home of MU men's basketball and the NBA's Milwaukee Bucks will go on sale in late spring or early summer. Any questions can be directed to the Marquette Ticket Office by calling 414-288-4668 (GOMU) or email.

The Golden Eagles and Badgers played in front of 17,037 fans at Fiserv Forum on Sept. 13, 2023, still an NCAA attendance record for an indoor regular season game. It remains a state record for attendance at a women's sporting event and ranks as the 15th-most attended NCAA women's volley-

ball match ever (including NCAA tournament play).

The 2024 NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball Championship title match drew 1.3 million viewers on network television (ABC), while the tournament itself was the most-consumed ever as more than 1.3 billion minutes were watched across all ESPN platforms.

The two perennial NCAA tournament participants each advanced

to NCAA regional competition last fall and the Badgers captured a national championship in 2021.

In addition to MU men's basketball games at Fiserv Forum, the building has partnered with Marquette to host the 2022 NCAA Men's Basketball Championship and will do so again with First & Second Round games on March 21-23 this spring

Make sure jerseys are compliant before ordering

The Badger Region Volleyball Association wants to make sure your team's jerseys are compliant with all rule sets and changes that have gone into effect.

To do so, the Region's Ref Chair is encouraging club directors or coaches to send images if there is any concern that numbers are not contrasting enough with the dominant color of the jersey or if a jersey is not contrasting for libero purposes.

The photos of the jerseys should not be of any junior athlete.

Reminder: All numbers must clearly contrast with the color of the jersey, regardless of the color of the outline of the number.

If your team plans to attend

a USA Volleyball Boys or Girls Qualifier or National Championship, the Region can also help direct you as to the proper channels you must go through to get jersey waivers.





Pair of officials advance to Regional certification



Monica Wang, left, and Amy Grycowski received their Regional certification at the last day of the Badger Region Power League on April 6 at Center Court in Waukesha. The Badger Region is very excited to announce its two most recent Regional officials: Amy Grycowski and Monica Wang. The two worked incredibly hard this year at many Badger Region events with a variety of high level Badger Region mentors.

"The regional advancement process has gone through some positive changes in the past couple years, and we are very happy with the comprehensive program we can offer to our Badger Region officials," said Badger Region Ref Chair Sara Voigt.

After serving a minimum of one year as a Provisional Referee, one may begin working toward their Regional certification. A Regional Referee should be able to officiate any match at any age level within Badger Region.

A Regional Referee must have a working knowledge of volleyball rules and mechanics, have good reffing mechanics and be proficient with the USAV scoresheet as a Provisional scorer. Most importantly, a Regional official must know how to transition to the R2 position, show awareness in rotational faults, show back-row knowledge, bench awareness and control, and match play anticipation.

Applications for the 2026 class of Regional officials candidates will open in the fall. Officials must be in good standing with the Region to be eligible for advancement next year.

Refs receive Provisional patches at Badger Region events

A handful of Badger Region officials received their Provisional patches at the Badger Region Championships in March.

To become a Provincial Ref, an individual must demonstrate and successfully apply rules and refereeing mechanics.

Provisional Referees are assigned to matches appropriate to their skill level, generally 14-and-under (with exceptions).





Region to host 2025 All-Star event

Madison chosen for elite tournament

The Badger Region Volleyball Association and the Madison Area Sports Commission (MASC) are proud to announce that Madison and the Alliant Energy Center have been selected to host the 2025 USA Volleyball All-Star Championships. The event will feature All-Star teams from across the country composed of boys and girls players, ages 13-19, as well as officials from around the nation.

Madison was selected from various sites around the country by the participating programs. It will be the first time a Wisconsin city has hosted this prestigious event since 2010, when it was held in Wisconsin Dells.

"We are very proud to be hosting this event in Madison, in partnership with the Madison Area Sports Commission," said Badger Region Volleyball Executive Director and Commissioner Jennifer Armson-Dyer. "Wisconsin is a hotbed of volleyball at all levels, and to be able to bring this event to our local community is very rewarding. We're looking forward to showing the juniors volleyball community what Madison is about."

The event will take place in late July 2025 at the Alliant Energy Center and will feature four days of competition across nine divisions of both boys and girls volleyball ages 13-19. More than 100 participating teams will come from the 40 regions of USA Volleyball along with international teams. In the past, teams from Canada, Puerto Rico, Australia and New Zealand have attended the event.

Not only will players, coaches and spectators travel from around the nation to Madison, but officials will as well. Each participating region sends experienced and up-and-coming officials to work the event and be mentored by world-class officials to gain experience officiating high-level volleyball and making important connections to further

their careers.

"Hosting this prestigious tournament in Madison -- one of the epicenters of volleyball has long been a goal of ours," said Jamie Patrick, VP of MASC. "We look forward to continuing our partnership with Badger Region Volleyball to welcome athletes and their fans to compete, cheer and enjoy volleyball and activities in the indelible Madison."

The All-Star Championships started in the early 2000s as an elite-level event designed to showcase regional All-Star teams along with national training teams from USA Volleyball, the national governing body of volleyball in the United States, in multiple age divisions. Previously known as the High Performance Champion-

ships, the USA Volleyball All-Star Championships are now run by the Regional Volleyball Associations and it is endorsed by USA Volleyball as a "pipeline" event to the National Team Development and Olympic programs.

Badger Region has been a participant in this event since its beginning, capturing 15 medals, including most recently a bronze medal by the U13 girls team last July in Fort Lauderdale, Fla., and a gold medal by the U17 boys and U17 girls teams in 2022 in Tulsa, Okla. The 2024 All-Star Volleyball Championships will be held in Des Moines, Iowa in mid-July. Information about the Badger Region Volleyball tryouts for the 2024 teams will be announced in January.



How is the Badger Region Board structured?

The Badger Region Volleyball Association is governed by a Board of Directors that must be elected by members on a regular basis. Area reps serve three-year terms, while members of the executive board serve four-year terms.

Members, whether they are players, coaches, parents, directors, athletic trainers or officials, are encouraged to communicate with their respective representative if they

think policies or financial decision in the Region need to be changed.

Some policies enforced by Badger Region come from USA Volleyball, our sport's national governing body, so those can't be changed. But many others can.

The Board is advised by a 11 chairpersons (or experts) in various parts of the game, and five staff members (some of which have multiple responsibilities).

The state is divided into five parts geographically for representation. Plus, there are two at-large board members who you can approach if you don't feel comfortable with your current rep. And there is a rep dedicated just to issues that surround our Junior volleyball clubs and athletes.


